The Making of a Disciple

2 Timothy 1:1-7

Today, we start our series on the letter of 2 Timothy. The Apostle Paul, who is nearing the end of his life, writes this letter to Timothy entrusting the Gospel to him by the power of the Holy Spirit. This morning we will look at 3 means of grace that God used to transform, and continue to transform Timothy into His servant.

1. Timothy had a personal mentor

- Who wanted God's best for him
- Who constantly prayed for him
- Who loved the Lord and him

2. Timothy had a godly mother and grandmother

- They both had a sincere faith
- An unhypocritical faith

3. Timothy had the Holy Spirit, His gifts

- Power
- Love
- Self-control
