A STUDY IN 2 TIMOTHY

Present Yourself as one approved

2 Timothy 2:14-26

This morning we will look at three images that Paul, inspired by the Holy Spirit, tells Timothy to fashion his teaching ministry after. Timothy's life and teaching is to be dramatically different from the false teacher's. As disciples of Christ, at some level, we are all commissioned and empowered to be faithful teachers of the one, true gospel.

Remind them of 'these things'

A teacher of God's Word/Disciple of Christ is to be:

1. An Unashamed Worker (Vs.15-19)
 - a. A Good Worker
 - b. A Bad Worker
2. A Clean Vessel (Vs.20-22)
3. A Servant of the Lord (Vs.23-26)

3. How does quarreling affect the life of the church?
4. Is the bodily resurrection of Jesus and His children a central teaching?
5. How and why does false teaching spread so rapidly?
6. How do we respond to blatant false teaching?
7. What 'youthful passions' have you seen in your own life? Which ones were/are good? Which ones have been sinful and you have worked at avoiding?
8. Are the teachings of God's Word different from the teachings of the culture on how to handle youthful passions?
9. What teachings are worthwhile to hold firm to? What kinds of teachings are we able to have a looser grip on?
